In the run up to our consultation period, which began as we went into lock-down, we assumed that transport would be the town's main focus for concern.

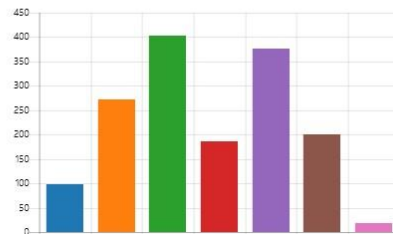
It isn't. In fact, it came third in your list of priorities.
